Senior session: Warm-up TBA, to commence after completion of Junior session.

Nominations

All event nominations can be made through Swim Central.
The entry process is only available to financial Swimming Australia competitive members.

Swimmers can swim a maximum of 5 events.

Entry is open to all SQ-registered competitive swimmers who meet the restricted criteria.

Eligibility

50m events: 8 years & over
100m Freestyle: 8 years & over
100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly: 12 years & over
200m Freestyle & Individual Medley: 12 years & over

Age

The minimum age is 8 as of 4th October 2026

Nominations Close	11.59 pm Tuesday 15th September 2026. Nominations will close early if numbers or timeframes are met. Entries will be capped at 150 swimmers and/or 2 ½ hours duration per session.
Event Fees	\$10.00 per event (Swim Central transaction fees will be applied in the cart). Spectator Entry Fee - FREE.
Multiclass	MC swimmers are welcome and will be seeded by age and Time.
Late Entries	Strictly no late entries are accepted.
Events	All events will be swum as timed finals. In consultation with the referee, the technical manager reserves the right to combine heats on the day.
Refunds	Refunds will only be given for withdrawal from the meet due to medical reasons and on presentation of a medical certificate. To request a refund, please email your refund request with a medical certificate within 7 days of the meet to info@thecentenarydolphins.com and apply for your refund through Swim Central.
Programs	A PDF version of the program will be sent to all swimmers prior to the day of competition. No programs will be available for sale on the day.
Awards	Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the following age groups: 50m Events: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years & over 100m Freestyle: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years & over 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly: 12, 13, 14, 15 years & over 200m Freestyle & Individual Medley: 12, 13, 14, 15 years & over
Timekeeping	A timekeeping roster will be emailed to Race Secretaries closer to the meet date. All clubs competing are asked to provide timekeepers based on the number of nominated swimmers.
Food & BBQ	There will be a BBQ running and the kiosk will be open for coffee, soft drinks and other goodies.
